How to take part



What is The Strategic Review?



The Strategic Review is an opportunity to work with a team of six senior executives, who will provide clear, actionable recommendations on how to address a key strategic issue currently faced by your organisation.

The benefits:

- Focus on a specific strategic issue, through a short engagement.
- The opportunity to reflect on your current position and potential next steps.
- Continuation of strategic planning from your initial Pilotlight engagement (previous partner charities).

What is the selection process?



Invitation:

Previous Pilotlight partners and new charities are able to apply to The Strategic Review.



Application:

The charity submits a brief expression of interest detailing the strategic issue to be addressed.



Follow up:

A call/meeting is arranged to understand the issue and how The Strategic Review can help.



If selected:

You and your Pilotlighter team will work together for approximately 10 hours over 2-3 months.

How does it work?



First meeting:
For the Pilotlighter team to get to know your organisation.



Second meeting:
With you and the team to learn about your current challenges and opportunities.



Team-only planning:
The Pilotlighter team
will have planning
meetings to prepare
their
recommendations.



Final meeting:
The team will
present their
recommendations
and discuss next
steps with you.

A Pilotlight Project Manager organises and facilitates all meetings, shares notes and materials, and provides a conduit between you and your Pilotlighter team.
